

Studio Policy

Private lessons are offered to students of any age and level. The curriculum for private lessons will be tailored to match each student's specific learning needs and goals. Details about location of in-person lessons and parking will be provided by email.

Tuition Rates: Private Lessons(violin, guitar, piano, voice)

Monthly (due, in full, by the 3rd of each month:

30-minute private lesson - \$30

60-minute private lesson - \$45

Non-monthly Rate:

60-minute private lesson - \$50

*please note 30 minute lessons are not offered without a monthly commitment

Invoices and Payment:

Invoices will be sent via email by the 25th of each month. Students have until the 3rd of the month to make payment for the entire month's lessons. Students may amend the amount of lessons before the 25th of each month. For example, if the student will only take two lessons in July but three in August, the student will inform the teacher by July 25th that they would like to add a lesson to the monthly invoice.

Cancellation and Make Up:

Students or parents will inform the teacher of cancellations 24 hours before their lesson time in order for a make up lesson to be scheduled.

Summer Lessons:

Lessons during the summer will continue and students may adjust their lesson time by the 25th of each month. Advanced notice of schedule changes are appreciated.

Illness:

Please respect not only the health of the teacher, but all other students who use the same instrument and space. If students are only mildly ill, please email or call so the teacher can do Zoom lesson during the student's scheduled lesson time or reschedule the student.

Lesson Termination:

At least one month of notice is required if a student decides to terminate lessons. The teacher reserves the right to terminate lessons. Failure to pay tuition, persistent absences, lack of materials at lessons, an uncooperative attitude, and lack of progress due to insufficient practice may result in lesson termination.

Student Responsibilities:

First and foremost, all students are expected to practice on a regular basis. Students should arrive at their lesson well prepared with all necessary materials. Piano, Violin, and Guitar students are also expected to maintain clipped fingernails in order to ensure proper technique.

Parent Responsibilities:

The success of the student may depend upon teacher-parent communication. Please check in on your child's practice and make sure they stays on task. Parents are expected to practice with young, beginning students. Parents should also see that their child arrives to his or her lesson on time. If a student arrives late, his or her lesson will not be extended past the scheduled time. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure the safe arrival and departure of their child. Encourage your child to have fun! We love the "process" in this studio and want everyone to find a fulfilling love of music.
